

Manual for preparation of documents

magnet, pin, bottle opener

Example:

Placing graphics in the mockup (of the selected size and shape),
if your graphics extends over or to the edge.



Green - The bleed circle - always min. around 5 mm larger
Red - Visible part of the button - does not print



Graphics with overlap
(the part of the badge that is used for folding)

Visible part of the button



Properly prepared graphics for printing



Preview of the finished button

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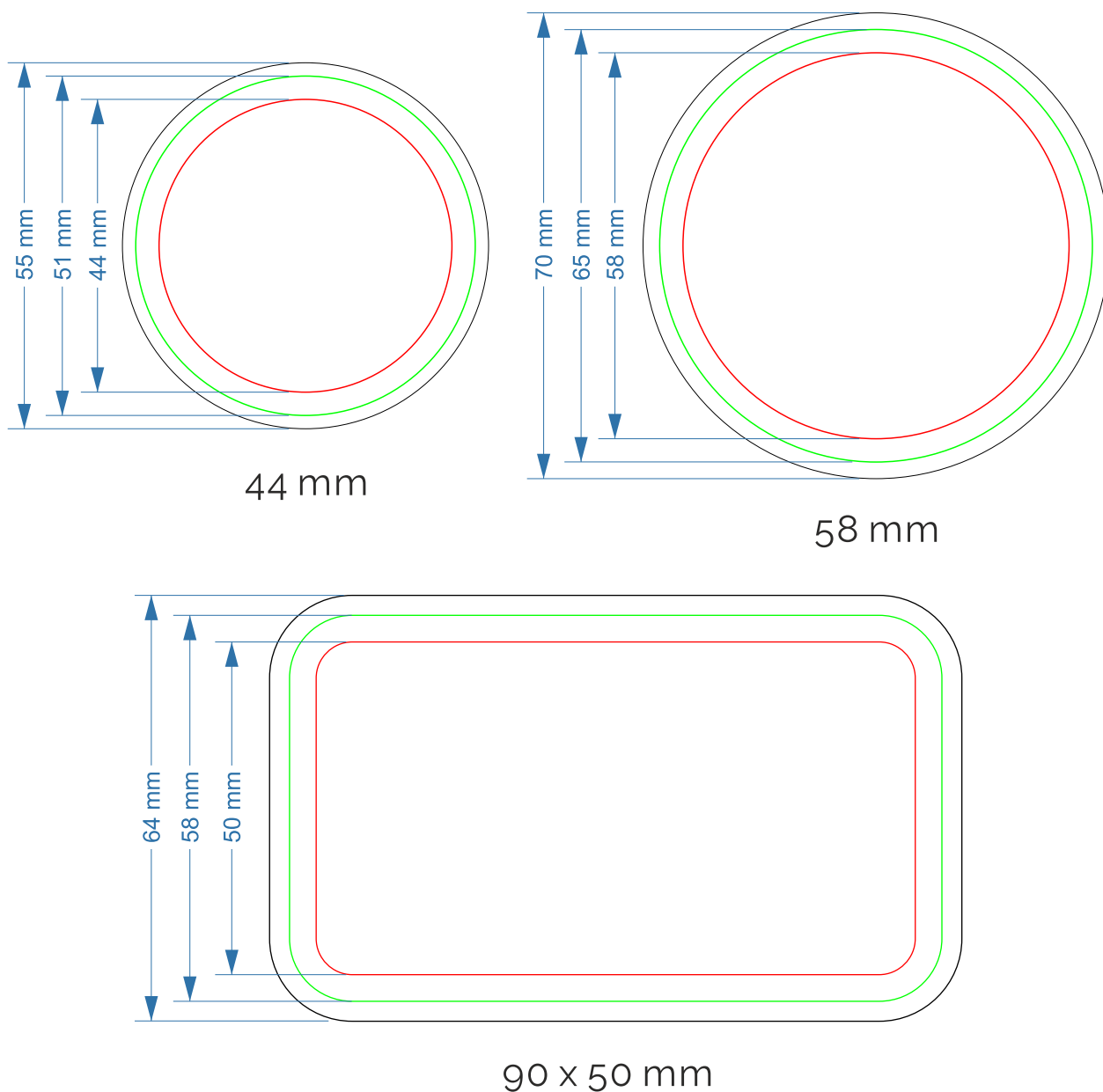
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Composition information:

Black circle - Please leave the black circle - it is used for cutting

Green circle - The green circle indicates the overlap of the graphics. This part of the button is located in the fold. Leave the background of your graphics up to the edge of the green circle so that a white border does not appear during assembly.

Red circle - Does not print! It is only used to show the size of the button after completion.



Note:

For better printing, we recommend converting the color of raster graphics to the color model **CMYK 300 DPI in 1:1** ratio and other objects in **vector curves**.
